Tu BiShvat (or Tu B'Shvat) is the Jewish "New Year for Trees," celebrated on the 15th of the Hebrew month of Shevat, usually in late January or February, marking the start of spring in Israel and a time to appreciate nature, plant trees, and enjoy fruits, especially the Seven Species like figs, dates, grapes, pomegranates, olives, wheat, and barley. It's a minor holiday with modern significance as an environmental awareness day, often celebrated with tree plantings and special ritual meals (seders) that echo the Passover seder
