MILDRED ENGEL NURSE SCHOLARSHIP

Mildred Engel committed her life to nursing.

After graduating from St. Elizabeth's School of Nursing, she went on to be a hospital-based nurse, a WWII Army nurse serving in the European Theatre, and a private-duty nurse in her lifetime. Well into her career, she graduated from Youngstown State University with a B.S. in Nursing— a degree that was not available when she started her career. She was persistent in her efforts to get her B.S. no matter what her age.

With her B.S. in hand, she was able to teach nursing at both St. Elizabeth's Hospital Medical Center and Trumbull Memorial Hospital. Nursing was her passion and, as a result, she established this scholarship fund. By doing so, she is making it possible to provide educational opportunities for qualified, committed, and caring nurses for the future at Heritage Manor and the community.

ABOUT THE SCHOLARSHIP

The scholarship award may cover tuition and transportation costs up to \$10,000.00 annually. A yearly application will be required in order to receive continued assistance.

Applicants must be accepted into an accredited RN nursing program. Residency should be within a 60 mile radius of the Youngstown area. Applicants may be considered in a provisional manner dependent on official acceptance into an approved RN program.

One of the following must occur:

- A. Recipient will be required to work at least three (3) shifts per month in a desired capacity (i.e., RN, LPN, or STNA (Heritage Manor will train STNAs)) while attending school for one year for any amount awarded up to \$8,000; and at least two years for monies awarded above \$8,000 per year up to the maximum amount of \$10,000 per student per year. Shifts are a minimum of eight (8) hours. Recipients will be paid a wage in addition to the scholarship.
- B. Recipient must work for Heritage Manor as an RN, ideally as a full time RN but at least as a PRN RN for three (3) shifts per month, for at least one year for any amount awarded up to \$8,000; and at least two years for monies awarded above \$8,000 per year up to the maximum amount of \$10,000 per student per year. Shifts are a minimum of eight (8) hours. If no positions are available within thirty (30) days upon receiving licensure, Recipient will be released from the commitment to work for Heritage Manor. If the recipient does not fulfill this requirement, they must pay back the scholarship per Agreement.

Applicants must wait at least 12 months from receipt of an award to submit another request.
